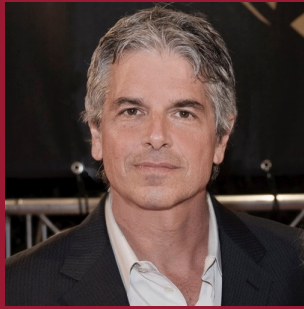

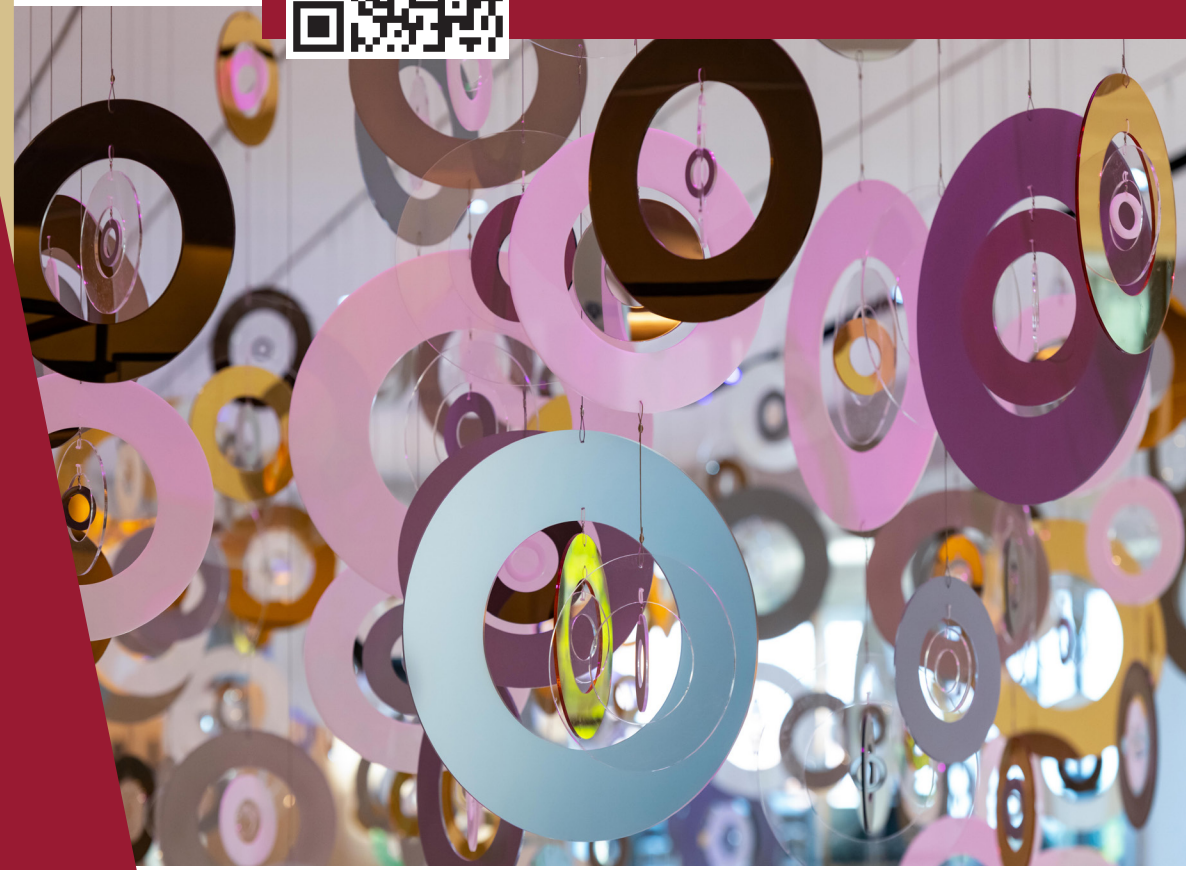

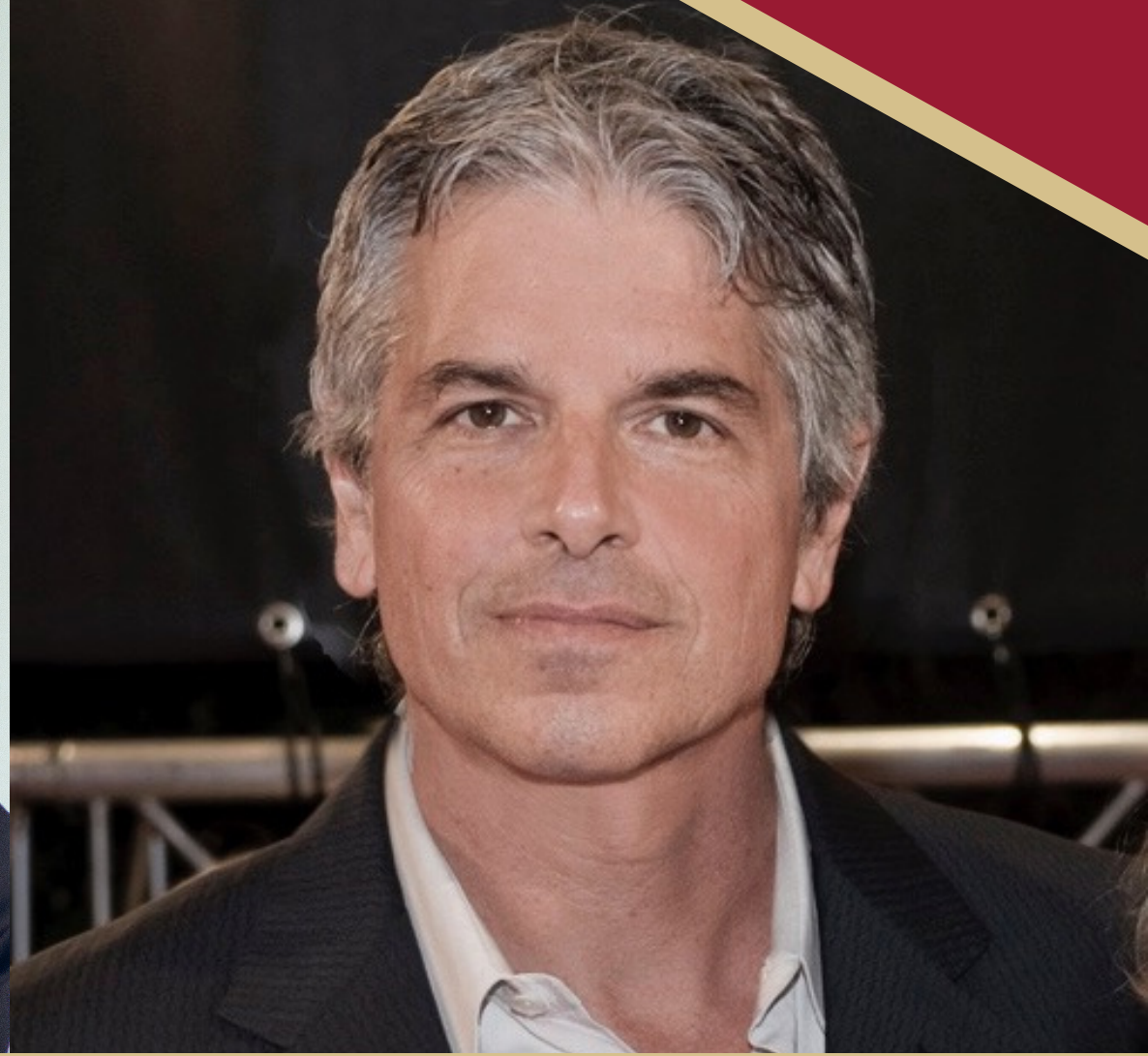


SULLY SULLENBERGER

SEPTEMBER 14, 2023

"208 SECONDS: A LIFETIME OF LESSONS"

Sully is the retired American fighter pilot, diplomat and airline pilot best known for his heroism as captain of US Airways Flight 1549 that he ditched in the Hudson River in 2009 after both engines were disabled by a bird strike. All 155 people aboard survived. He was the subject of "Sully," a 2016 feature film starring Tom Hanks in the title role. Recently, the Aviation Museum in Charlotte was named for him.



WALTER PARKES

OCTOBER 12, 2023

"MAKING MOVIES AND CREATING NEW EDUCATIONAL EXPERIENCES"

Walter is a screenwriter and producer of more than 50 films. He was President of Steven Spielberg's Amblin Entertainment and, later, head of Dreamworks motion picture division, overseeing film projects including three consecutive Best Picture Oscar winners. He is now developing virtual reality educational experiences with Dreamscape Immersive, his entertainment and technology company.

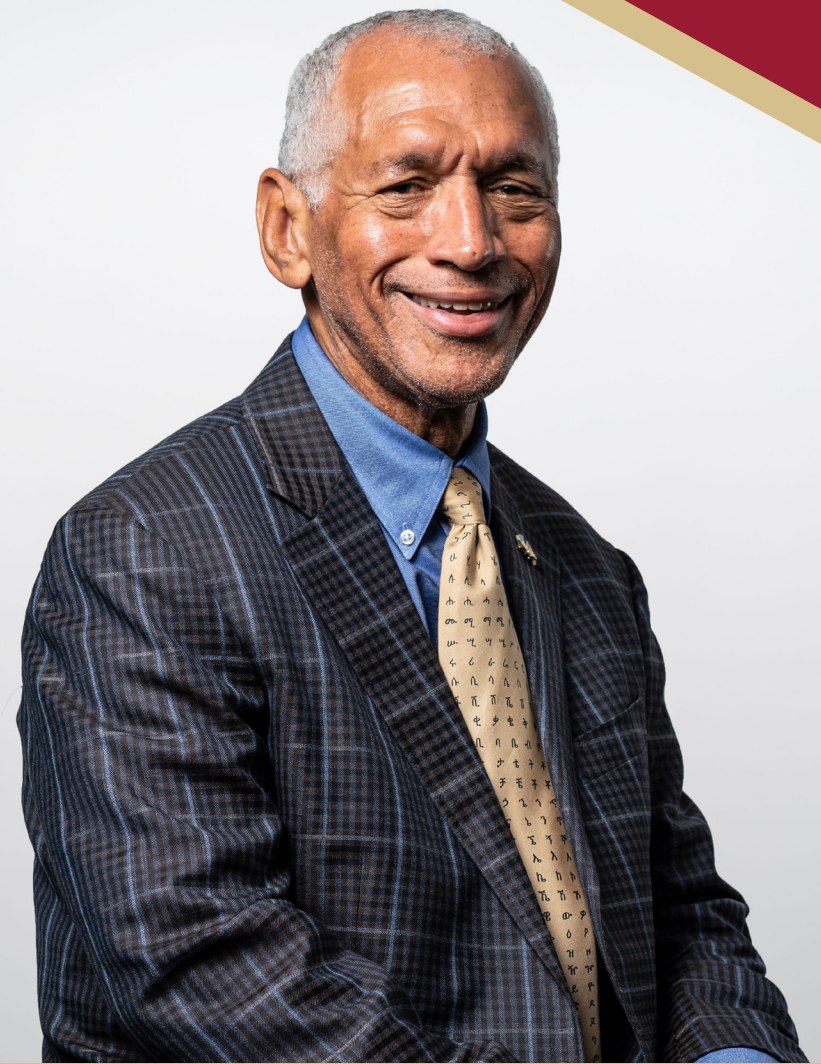


LYNSEY ADDARIO

Lynsey is an American photojournalist who has been covering conflict, humanitarian crises and women's issues in the Middle East and Africa on assignment for The New York Times and National Geographic for more than two decades. She is the recipient of numerous awards including the Pulitzer Prize and the MacArthur Fellowship. Hollywood has acquired the rights to make a film out of her life story.



CHARLES BOLDEN

FEBRUARY 8, 2024

"DREAMING BIG: THE PAST, PRESENT, AND FUTURE OF HUMAN SPACE EXPLORATION"

Charles served as the 12th NASA Administrator (2009-17) and was the first African American and only the second former astronaut to hold the position. As NASA Administrator he oversaw the transition from 30 years of Space Shuttle missions to a new era of exploration focused on full utilization of the International Space Station, among other accomplishments. He was commander of the Space Shuttle Atlantis in 1992 and Space Shuttle Discovery in 1994 and flew two other missions as a pilot. His mentor in the astronaut program was Ronald McNair, N.C. A&T graduate and a fellow South Carolinian. He flew over 100 combat missions during the Vietnam War.

Judy is a trailblazing broadcast journalist who has worked in network, cable and public television news for nearly 50 years. She was the anchor and managing editor of the "PBS NewsHour" through the end of 2022, and for a period was co-anchor with former Bryan Series speaker Gwen Ifill. The Duke grad has covered every presidential election and convention since 1976 and moderated U.S. presidential debates.

NEIL DEGRASSE TYSON

NOVEMBER 16, 2023

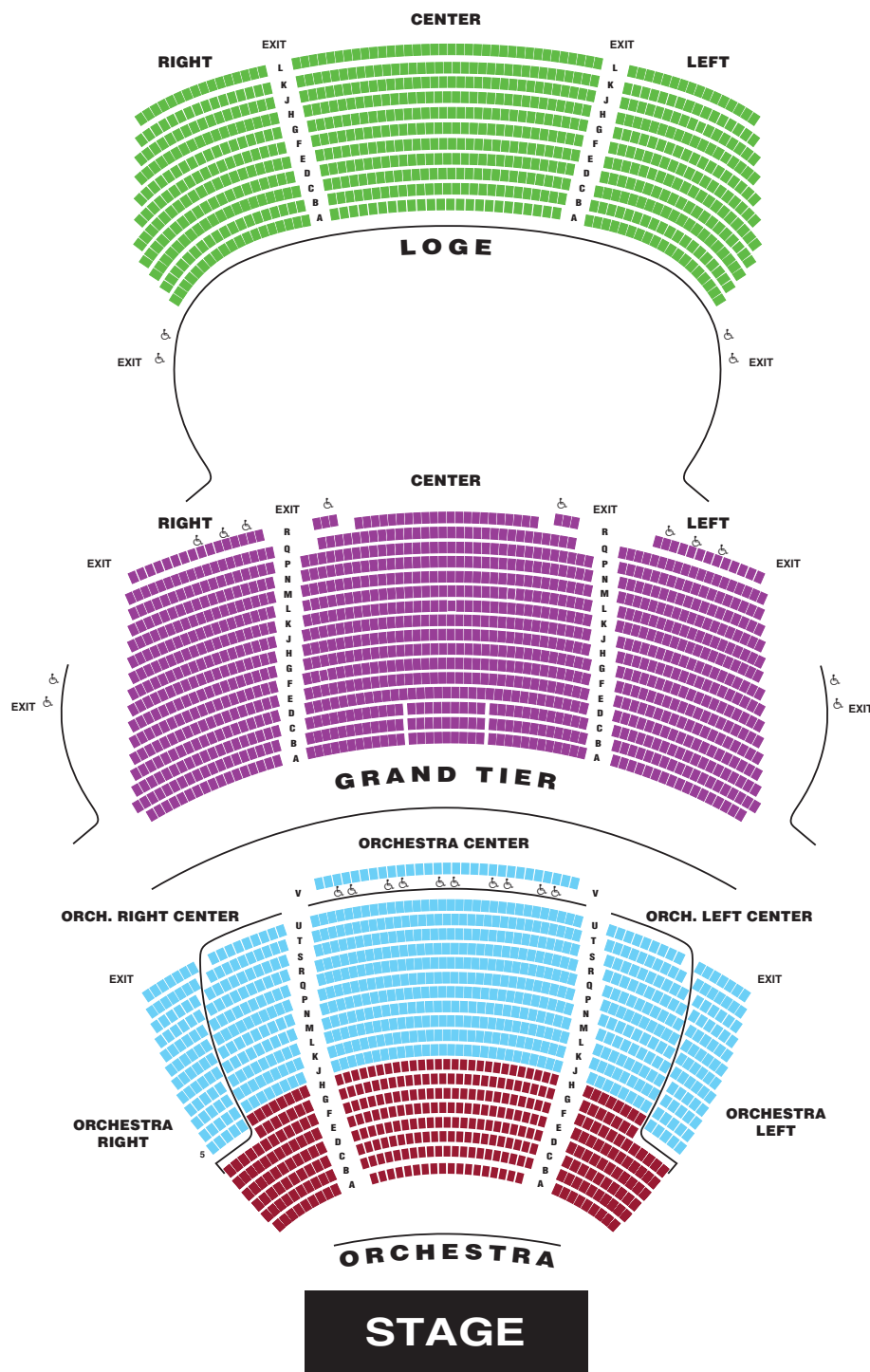
Neil deGrasse Tyson is the Director of the Hayden Planetarium at the Rose Center for Earth and Space in New York City, as well as a renowned astrophysicist. He is the recipient of twenty-one honorary doctorates and the NASA Distinguished Public Service Medal, the highest award given by NASA to a non-government citizen.

He will speak about The Cosmic Perspective: There is no view of the world as emotionally potent as the one granted by a cosmic perspective. It's one that sees Earth as a planet in a vast empty universe. It profoundly influences what we think and feel about science, culture, politics, and life itself.

Listening Devices | Headsets may be checked out from the Guest Services desk located on the main lobby level. Since our ALD devices work with most standard headphones, you are welcome to bring your own. If you are unable to bring your own headphones, we can provide a set for you. The Tanger Center is T-Coil compliant. If your hearing aids or cochlear implants have a built-in telecoil, you will be able to link up to our loop sound system without the use of an additional device.



ASL Interpreters | Tanger Center provides interpreters for entertainment events free of charge to the hearing impaired. To arrange for an interpreter, please call Guest Services at 336-333-6516 and ask for assistance. Interpreters should be requested one month out prior to the event to ensure proper service and scheduling. However, we will make every effort to solicit interpreters on short notice. Patrons who request interpreters may need to be seated together.

MOBILE TICKETING

Season tickets will be mailed in Summer 2023, approximately one month prior to the season beginning. We encourage you to check out the benefits and ease of mobile ticketing by visiting TangerCenter.com/GoMobile.

HOW CAN I CHANGE MY SEAT LOCATION?

In the coming months, we will be sending emails with the times and options for exchanging and adding-on tickets to your season plan. Remember, you must renew your current seats to be eligible for an upgrade.

HOW DO I REDUCE THE NUMBER OF SEATS I WANT TO RENEW?
