he Steven Tanger Center for the Performing Arts was completed in March of 2020 and is projected to host more than 150 events per year. Managed by the staff of the Greensboro Coliseum Complex, the Tanger Center is home to a diverse variety of events including first-run national Broadway performances in partnership with Nederlander and Professional Facilities Management, concerts, Guilford College's Bryan Series, Greensboro Symphony Orchestra performances, comedy shows and all types of family entertainment.

- Construction features, Phillips Hall, a limestone and glass lobby of 8,000 square feet, ample backstage support and storage space for touring Broadway shows, concerts and Symphony events and over 325 on-site parking spaces.
- The Tanger Center includes three seating areas orchestra, grand tier and loge – creating 3,023 seats, making it one of the largest theatres between Atlanta and Washington, DC.
- The facility includes 70 line sets, a full complement of stage draperies, an oversized stage with orchestra lift to a working basement, chorus, principal and star dressing rooms and other support space to host the largest traditional concerts and Broadway theatre events.
- The house has sound/light locks, acoustical treatments on walls, under floor HVAC, wider than normal seats, row spacing and restrooms on all levels.
- The facility includes both a line array sound system and an electronic acoustical enhanced sound system for symphonic, opera and speaking events.

Located in the heart of North Carolina's Piedmont Triad region – including Greensboro, Winston-Salem and High Point the Tanger Center is just a five-hour drive to northern Virginia, middle Tennessee or southern Georgia.

Your event will find Greensboro to be the easiest stop in the Carolinas, and the midway point along the east coast of the United States.



AREA OVERVIEW

Region

 North Carolina's Piedmont Triad Region comprises 12 diverse counties in central North Carolina surrounding the cities of Greensboro, Winston-Salem and High Point.

Population

- The 12-county region has a total population of more than 1.7 million residents, and the region is growing at a rate of approximately 1% per year.
- The Piedmont Triad is the 33rd largest metro region in the nation. By comparison, Raleigh-Durham is 29th, Charlotte is 20th, Virginia Beach is 32nd, and Jacksonville, Fla. is 34th.
- The combined population of the Piedmont Triad, Charlotte-Concord, and Raleigh-Durham-Chapel Hill metro areas of North Carolina is approximately 6.64 million residents, ranking it slightly ahead of the metro Atlanta area at 6.63 million and slightly behind the metro Miami-Fort Lauderdale area at 6.87 million.

Employment

- With a workforce of more than 818,000 workers, the Piedmont Triad is part of the growing economy along the I-85 corridor between Charlotte and Raleigh.
- North Carolina has the lowest union enrollment rate in the nation at 2.7%.
- The economy is based on a diversifying manufacturing and distribution base, with important and growing office/headquarters and medical/health care industries.
- The average annual unemployment rate for the Piedmont Triad Region in 2018 was 3.9%.










SEATING *MAP*



FLOOR PLAN - CELLAR / ORCHESTRA PIT




FLOOR PLAN - 1ST FLOOR / PHILLIPS HALL








FLOOR PLAN - 2ND FLOOR / GRAND TIER

TANGER CENTER OPERATIONS

Advertising

The Tanger Center maintains a full-service advertising agency to assist promoters, meeting planners and event producers in the marketing of public events. Staff positions consist of a Broadway Services Marketing Director, Family and One Night Advertising Manager, Advertising Specialist for social media and graphics, part-time Group Sales Coordinator, and a Sponsorship Sales Manager. Staff can create customized comprehensive promotional, advertising and group sales campaigns for a wide variety of events.

By utilizing the Tanger Center advertising department, facility users receive the benefit of market expertise, bulk buying power with highly discounted print rates and the uniqueness of having a trained in-house staff person attending to the marketing needs of each contracted special event.

Sound, Lights & Video

The Tanger Center features two state-of-the-art sounds systems - the innovative Meyer Sound Constellation electronic acoustic enhancement system for symphonic concerts and a separate amplified sound system for touring Broadway shows, pop/rock concerts, comedians and speaking events. The amplified sound system was installed by Greensboro-based SE Systems, Inc., a nationally acclaimed production company. Television monitors are located by the lobby sound and light locks to track show progress. Daktronics manufactured indoor LED video displays are installed at each side of the stage to inform and entertain audiences and fans. Each display measures nearly 9.5 feet wide by 16.5 feet tall (vertical hang) and features 6-millimeter line spacing to bring the highest image clarity and contrast to every seat. Upcoming events are promoted on the facility's outdoor Daktronics marquee that uses a 13HD pixel layout to bring crisp, clear imagery to people as they arrive. The outdoor display measures approximately 20.5 feet high by 36 feet wide.

Box Office and Ticketing

The Tanger Center has an exclusive ticketing services agreement with Ticketmaster. The Tanger Center requires all ticketed events to utilize venue ticketing services and sales agents. Ticket commissions, credit card fees and day of show seller rates are charged for such services.

Cleaning and Custodial Services



The Tanger Center staff provides cleaning and general housekeeping in all areas throughout the facility during move-ins and event hours. The Tanger Center has also instituted our Patron Health Initiative, a program dedicated to the safety of our patrons, staff and performers stemming from the COVID-19 outbreak. We are committed to an increased level of cleaning and safety for those who come through our doors.

Equipment Services

The Tanger Center maintains a comprehensive list of equipment for in-house event use. Any and all additional equipment and services provided through the venue from outside vendors shall be billed at the rate in effect at the time said equipment and services are provided plus 15% service fee. Please contact your assigned Event Manager for an estimate of needed services.

Event Staffing/Crowd Management

For the public safety of all guests attending Tanger Center events, qualified event staff and public safety officers are required to be on site for all event related activities. Rates for such services will be charged at the prevailing rate in effect at the time of the contracted event"s usage. Event estimates for facility operating and staffing expenses will be provided by the assigned Event Manager upon request.

The Tanger Center has contracted for crowd management responsibilities through a regional entertainment staff service company who provide licensed crowd management staff for all events.

Group Sales

Tanger Center Sales is the exclusive provider of group sales services in the facility. The Tanger Center services groups through direct solicitation of local businesses, schools, community groups, churches and other organizations. Group sales is a tremendous source of alternative sales and the venue takes an aggressive approach to group solicitation with a part-time staff person dedicated to this effort. To discuss group sales opportunities, please contact your marketing representative.

IATSE Stagehands

Stagehands in Local 574 provides all load-in/out services for local decorator and on-stage performances.

Standard rates are quoted plus taxes and administration for general stagehands. Loaders and Riggers are priced separately. Performance rates and breaks apply. Daily and weekly overtime is applicable. Riggers are at a higher rate per hour. Please contact the assigned Event Manager for an estimate of services needed.

Spectra Food Services & Hospitality

The Tanger Center has an exclusive catering service available for clients with full service from a state-of-the-art kitchen inside the facility. Clients can select from a wide variety of standard menus or create a specialized menu for banquet functions as needed.


